Homemade Bavarian Pretzel homemade, hand twisted, salted, pretzel cooked to a perfect golden brown then basted in butter, served w/ Bavarian mustard and your choice of homemade beer cheese or queso blanco | \$9.59

Potato Pancakes four fluffy homemade potato & onion pancakes, pressed by hand, & spiced just right, served w/ your choice of apple sauce or sour cream | \$8.99

Bratwurst Sandwich two Bavarian brats grilled w/ homemade sauerkraut & mustard on a Portuguese roll served w/ a side of sweet & sour pickles | \$14.99 ⁹ add \$2.99

Chicken Schnitzel traditionally prepared lemon seasoned, panko crusted chicken sauteed in butter, served w/ freshly squeezed lemon juice & golden roasted potatoes w/ a side of flavorful lemon wine sauce | \$17.99 ⁹ add \$2.99

Goulash Pot Pie savory braised beef stew, potatoes & carrots slow cooked and perfectly spiced, topped w/ a flaky pastry crust | \$17.99

Oktoberfest Beers - Prost!

Hofbräu Oktoberfestbier: Founded in 1589, Hofbräu München is one of six breweries granted the privilege of supplying the Official Oktoberfest in Munich with their product. First brewed in 1810 for the wedding celebration of Crown Prince Ludwig, Oktoberfestbier is brewed according to the German Purity Law with the highest quality ingredients. Hofbräu Oktoberfestbier is golden in color, full bodied & palatable with a slightly sweet finish. 6.3% ABV **half liter \$8 | liter \$15**

Hacker-Pschorr Oktoberfest: Nestled in the heart of Munich, Hacker-Pschorr began as two separate breweries in 1417. An homage to the Bavarian Purity Laws of 1516, Hacker-Pschorr Oktoberfest was first brewed in 1810 and is one of the six beers allowed to be served at Oktoberfest in Munich. Slow roasted with Bavarian barley, it is caramelized to a rich, red amber color and combined with the purest spring waters from the Alps. Gloriously smooth, it's versatility is what sets this beer apart & gives it a distinct personality. 5.8% ABV **half liter \$8 | liter \$15**

Späten Oktoberfest: With a rich brewing history dating back over 600 years, Späten Franziskaner is one of the six breweries which operate within the walls of Munich and can serve beer at the Official Oktoberfest Festival. First brewed in 1872, Späten Oktoberfest is the world's first true Oktoberfest Beer. This amber colored brew has a rich malt flavor & smooth finish. 5.9% ABV **half liter \$8 | liter \$15**

Paulaner Oktoberfest: Founded in 1634, Paulaner first brewed Oktoberfest Bier in 1818. This golden lager is bottom-fermented and one of the six official beers allowed to be served at Oktoberfest in Munich. It is the pinnacle of German brewing—wonderfully mellow with balanced harmonious taste with a strong note of malt. 6.0% ABV **half liter \$8 | liter \$15**

Sam Adams Oktoberfest: First brewed in 1989 Samuel Adams' rich, roasty Märzen is a präst to fall and the most popular and widely distributed beers of it's style in the United States. Its boasts a deep amber color, mild pleasant sweetness, and light hop character. 5.3% ABV **half liter \$7.5 | liter \$14**

Oktoberfest Bottles & Cans

Augustiner-Bräu Edelstoff - Brewing since 1328, Augustiner was established as a private brewery in 1829 and is one of the six breweries allowed to serve beer at the Official Oktoberfest Festival. This Munich-style Helles Lager boasts a bright straw yellow color with a balanced sweetness laced with hop-bitter nuances. *Dortmunder Export Lager* 5.6% ABV **\$7.5**

Departed Soles Mars'N Attacks - *Gluten Free Marzen-style Lager* 5.8% ABV **\$7.5**

Non-Alcoholic Athletic Oktoberfest - *Marzen-style Lager* 0.5% ABV **\$6.5**
